

Objectives

“When the GIRINKA (one cow per one poor family program) was inspired and initiated by His Excellency the President of Republic of Rwanda in 2006 and approved by the cabinet in a cabinet meeting which took place on 12/04/2006 as a National Program of prime importance, which was set up within the vision 2020 and EDPRS for implementation measures ,and this was done with the aim of enabling every poor household to own and manage one improved dairy cow to help them acquire better livelihood and living conditions through increased milk and meat production.”

Strategies that will be used to achieve the disbursement of 1650 cows to poor families

For achieving the disbursement of 1000 cows to poor families, a tender will be open to the behalf of Huye District where 410 cows will be bought on the District budget, consultative meeting will be held with local non government organization true JADF, there will be else an identification of calves to be passed on during Girinka week.

Disbursing 1000 Cows in Girinka will answer this:

Girinka will led to the realization of Improved milk and meat production for families and improved family incomes from the sales of these two commodities, these families get increased animal manure for their farming activities; most importantly it will create and cement friendship and brotherhood between givers and recipients and it is helping to make the house hold economy grow.

Achievements in Livestock Production

In addition to the agriculture production, livestock is another source of income and food for agricultural households.

By the EICV 3, 69% of the households in Huye District raise the some type of livestock. According to EICV, 2.3% of the households have received the cow from this program and 12.6% have received animals from other programs.

By the contract of performance of 2011/2012, 1224 cows have been distributed while the target in 2012/2013 is 1294 cows, and in 2013-2014 1648 cows have been disbursed ,in 2014-2015 ;1315 cows disbursed at the closing of 2014-2015 Fiscal year we were about a total of 8024 cows disbursement .

In addition to the distribution of these livestock, there are also facilities related to livestock production including the milk collection center in Rusatira Sector as well as in Kinazi Sector.

In relation to the livestock, the markets for livestock have been constructed. These include the markets of Rugogwe and Karambi in Ruhashya and Karambi Sectors respectively.
